- The time limit of the video, for each participant, is **1-1.5 minutes**.
- Students can choose any form of prop. For example – finger puppets, favourite toys, doll houses, innovative virtual backgrounds.
- Innovation and creativity may include art integration or an interesting end to the story , puppetry etc.
- The video must be named in the given format: Name of the student, class and section.
