The topics for each grade are mentioned below:

Grade 6: Embodying the proverbial principle – 3 Monkeys. The three wise monkeys represent the moral message of not looking at, listening to, or saying anything evil, as well as to be morally upright. Illustrate your interpretation of any one of these values in the form of a banner. Material: A3 sheet, poster/acrylic colors, black sketch pen.

Grade 7: Clean India – Gandhiji's Vision "Cleanliness, Starts with me"

Cleanliness is an important aspect of life, it is a habit which is often considered just next to Godliness. It's the little things that can make a big difference. Keeping the thought, what can we do to keep our home, surroundings and nation clean and inspire others to do the same, prepare a digital poster showcasing your vision for clean India.

Grade 8: Universal Peace

Mahatma Gandhi was the biggest advocate of Universal Peace and Non-violence. The Gandhian philosophy can help individuals develop peace within themselves, in the society and the world as a whole. Each individual has his/her own interpretation of peace and how they want to practice it in their life. Keeping this thought in mind design a poster on the topic 'PEACE MEANS TO ME...'.

Material: A3 Sheet, black sketch pen, water colors, brushes.

Grade 9: Google -Doodle

'11 vows of Gandhi Ji'

Mahatma Gandhi is the symbol of peace and truth. Gandhian thoughts, principles, values and ideals encourage all to always follow the path of truth and practice non – violence. In order to celebrate the value propounded by Gandhi Ji, learners will create a doodle letter art on any one vow.

Material: A3 Sheet, black sketch pen, coloured markers.

Grade 10: Life of Mahatma Gandhi

How Gandhi Ji shaped our Independence movement: Taking instances from Mahatma Gandhi's journey, illustrate a scene through a sketch showcasing any one of his major life incidents.

Material: A3 Sheet, black sketch pen, poster/acrylic paints, brushes.

Winners will be awarded a certificate of merit. The artworks will be judged on the basis of the following criteria:

- -Creativity
- -Neatness
- -Originality
- -Drawing and colouring

Note: - One entry per student will be accepted.

- The photograph mailed for entry submission should be clear and it should have the child's name, class, and section.
- Digital poster to be sent in JPEG format.
- Participation of each child is mandatory.
- Entries to be submitted by 4th October, 2021.
